

CREIA Advanced Mentoring Program Report Review Guidelines

REPORT REVIEW STANDARDS:

- 1. The inspector's report shall conform to CREIA's currently approved and adopted Standards of Practice and Code of Ethics.
- 2. The inspector's report shall adequately address all of the items listed in the 10 Mandatory Sections of the CREIA Standards of Practice.
- 3. The inspector's report shall adequately address all of the items listed in the 2 Optional Sections of the CREIA Standards of Practice.
- 4. The inspector's verbiage of the report shall be consistent with the Definitions and Scope of the CREIA Standards of Practice.
- 5. The inspector's report, shall Disclose, Describe, and Direct Material Defects to the Appropriate Person/or Specialist for further evaluation. (**Note**: *If it's disclosed and described, it was detected.*)
- 6. The inspector's Report Review Panel Member (RRPM) shall identify areas of inadequate reporting or inappropriate use of verbiage.
- 7. The RRPM shall offer one or more suggestions for each unacceptable remark that would comply with sections 2 thru 6 above.
